



# The Planning Process

Transforming a garden is an investment in your home and your well-being. To make the process as smooth as possible, we break our design journey into four clear stages. This ensures you're always in the loop regarding both the design and the budget.

---

## Stage 1: The Initial Consultation

Every garden starts with a conversation. We'll visit your space to discuss your vision, how you use the garden (be it for entertaining, kids, or quiet contemplation), and your preferred style. A short questionnaire will be sent to you prior to our visit, this will help shape our conversation.

- **What you get:** A follow-up "Design Brief" summarising our discussion, including initial mood board images, and a fixed-price quote for the design stages.
  - **Timeframe:** 1 hour on-site.
- 

## Stage 2: Site Survey & Analysis

Before we can draw, we need to measure. We conduct a thorough survey of the existing garden, including levels, soil health, sun orientation, and existing features.

- **What you get:** An accurate scale drawing of your garden as it stands today.
  - **Timeframe:** 2–4 hours on-site.
  - **Cost:** From £250 (*Price varies depending on garden size*).
- 

## Stage 3: Concept Design & Moodboards

This is the "big ideas" phase. We'll present two or three different layouts for your garden, showing how we can use the space creatively.

- **What you get:**
  - Initial 2D layout sketches.
  - A "Moodboard" featuring materials, textures, and style inspiration.
  - A mid-way review meeting to pick your favorite elements. (1-2 hours)
- **Cost:** £250 (*Price varies depending on garden size*).

---

## Stage 4: The Final Master Plan

Once you've approved the concept, we refine it into a detailed Master Plan. This is the blueprint that contractors will use to build the garden.

- **What you get:**
  - To scale 2D Master Plan.
  - A 3D perspective sketch (so you can see the finished result).
  - An outline specification of materials (paving, timber, etc.).
  - A worksheet detailing the works required.
  - Specified planting for trees and larger shrubs.
  - A plant list of additional plants.
- **Cost: £500** (*Price varies depending on garden size*).

---

## Optional Add-on: The Planting

We prefer to layout and plant your garden ourselves, allowing us to adjust the planting when in the garden. This creates a more unique and intimate feel to the planting.

- **What you get:**
  - Improvement to the soil to increase the health of the planting.
  - All plants purchased and delivered to site.
  - Plant layout and planting of the garden.
  - Full mulch of the borders to complete the initial build.
- **Cost: £250 (plus cost of plants)** (*Price varies depending on garden size and quality of existing soil*).
